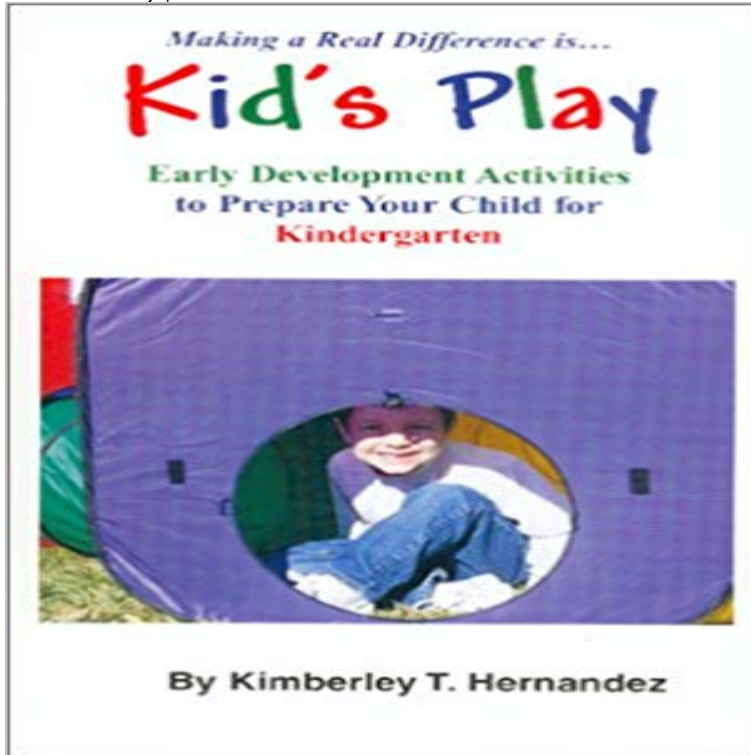


# Kids Play: Early Development Activities to Prepare Your Child For Kindergarten
