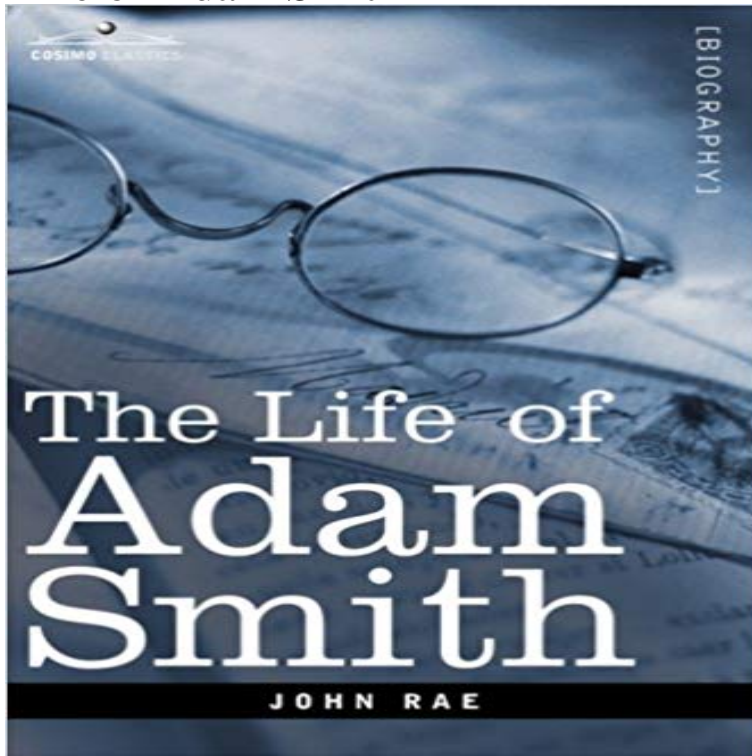


## Life of Adam Smith
