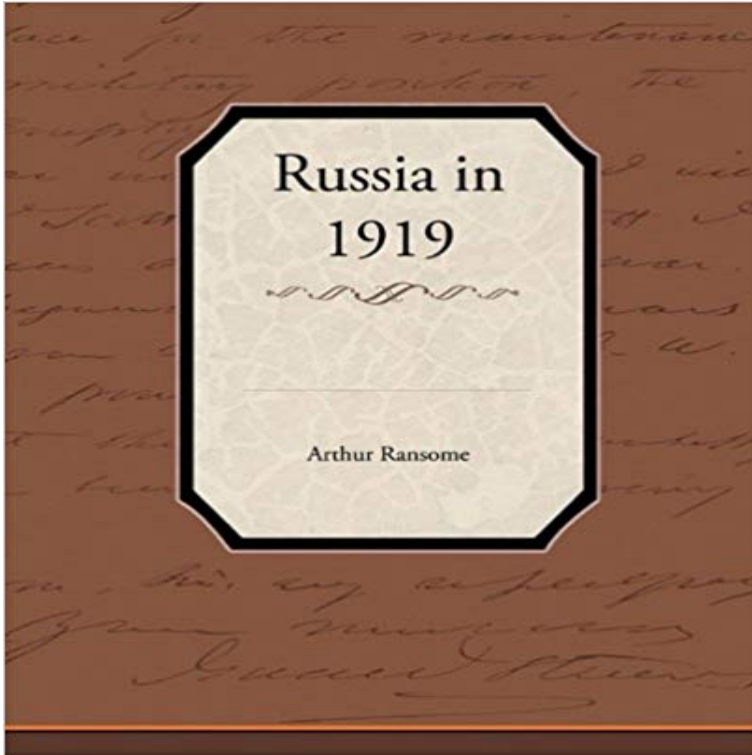


Russia in 1919
