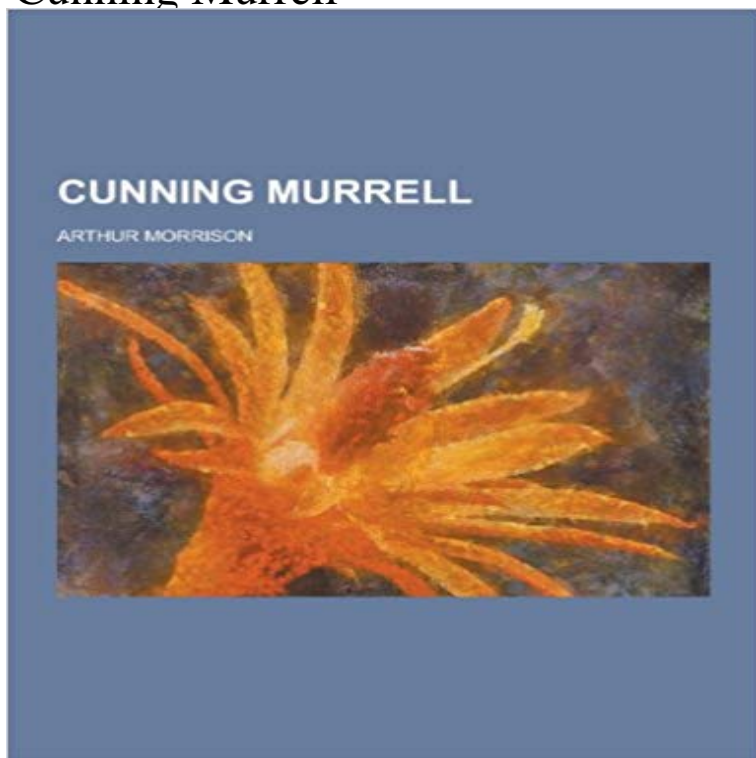


Cunning Murrell
