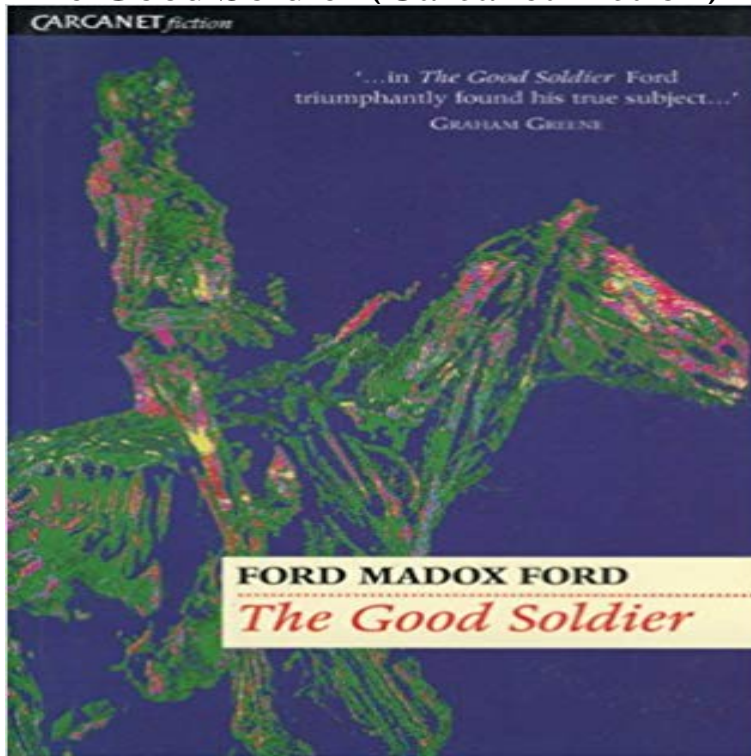


The Good Soldier (Carcanet Fiction)
