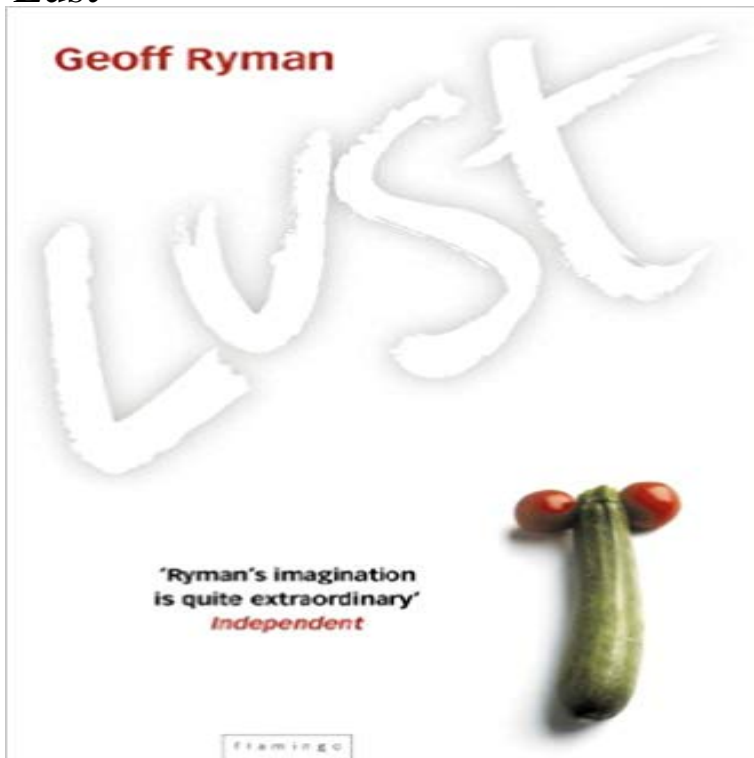


Lust
