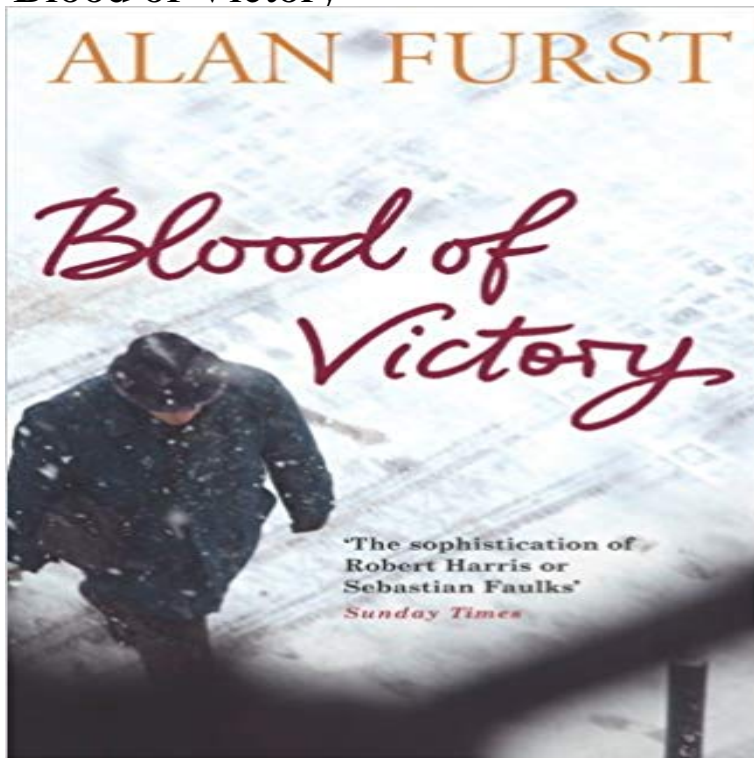


## Blood of Victory
