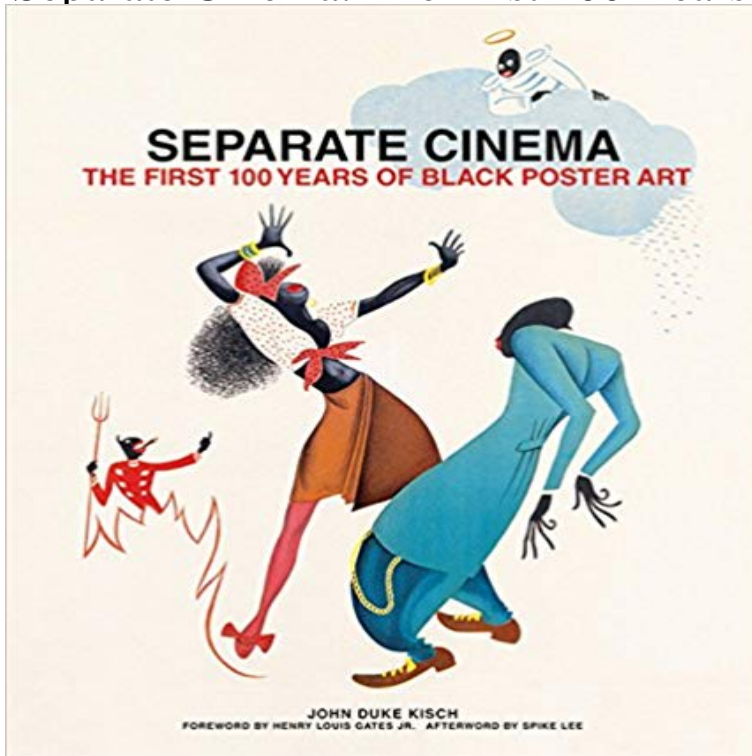


## Separate Cinema: The First 100 Years of Black Poster Art
