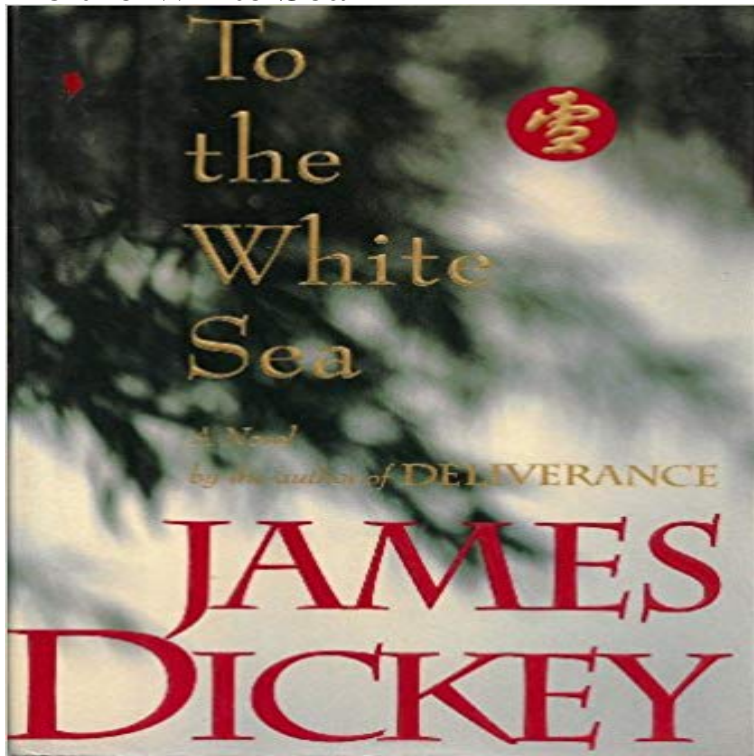


To the White Sea
