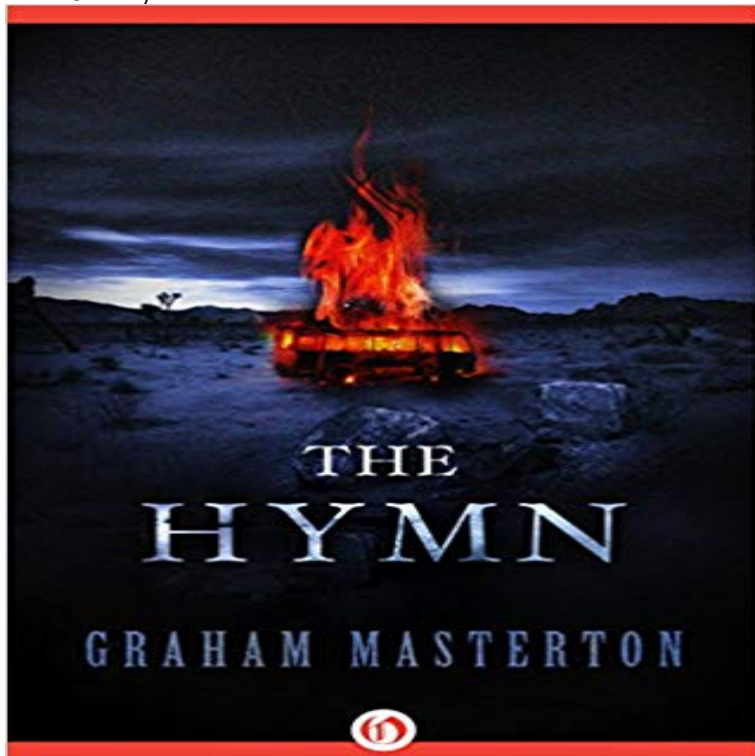


The Hymn
