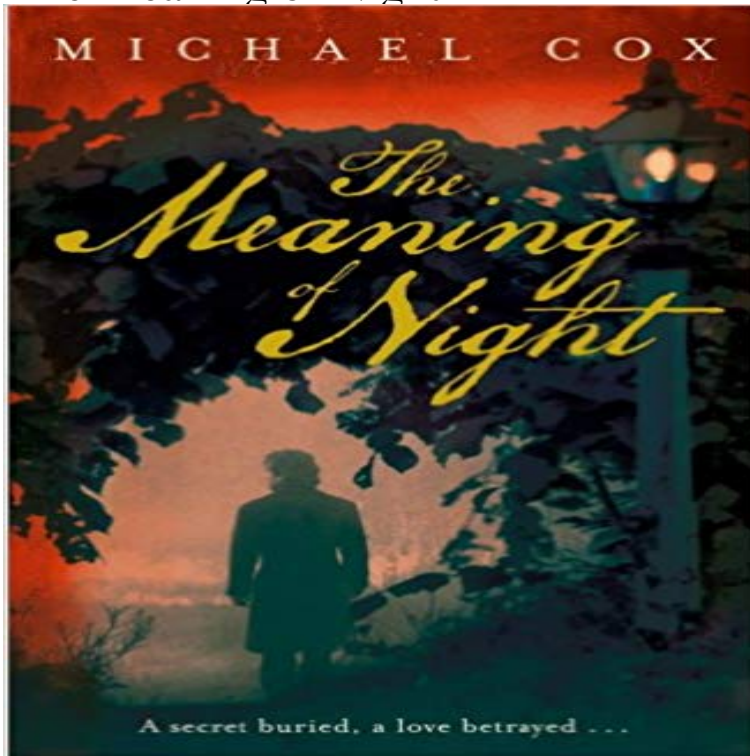


The Meaning of Night
