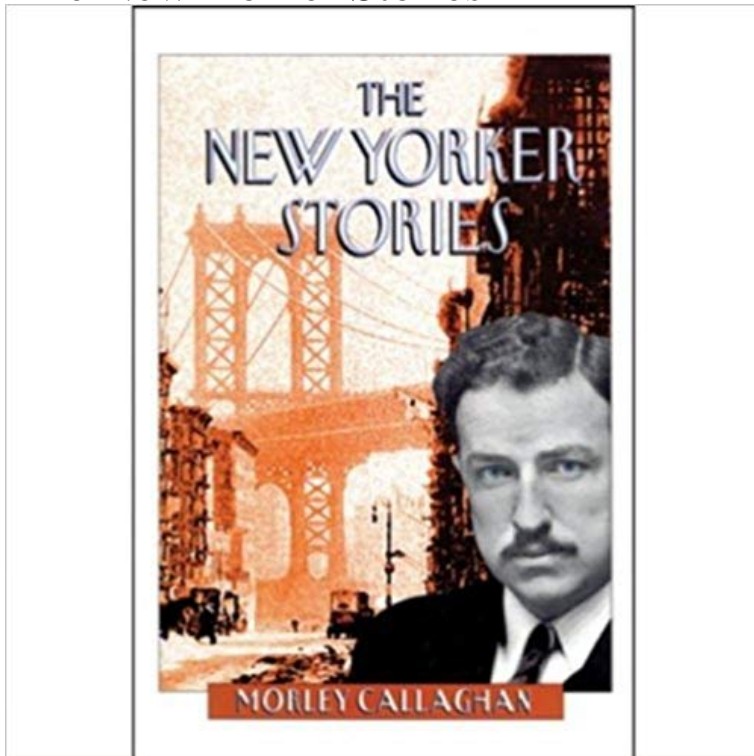


The New Yorker Stories
