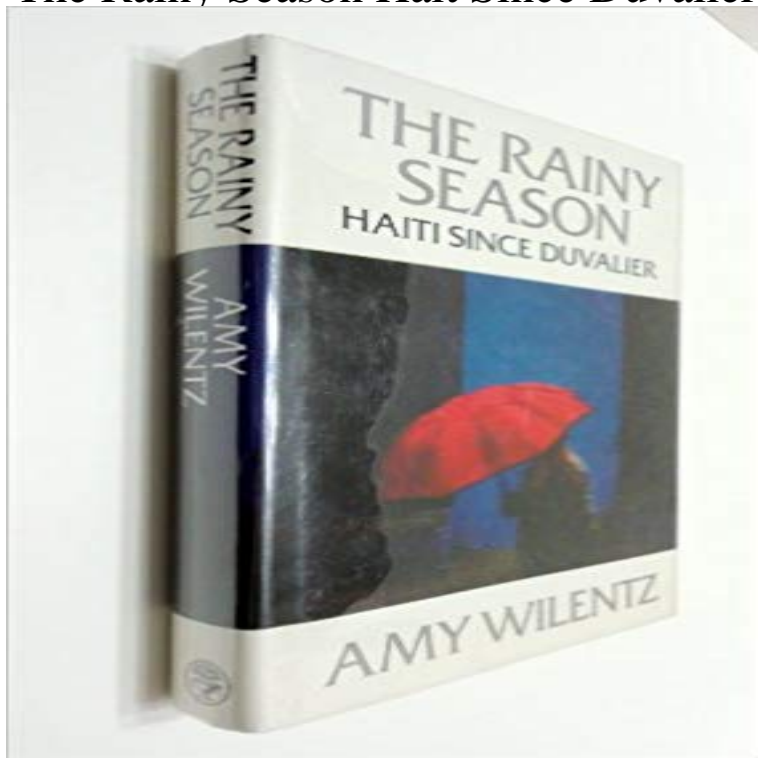


The Rainy Season Hait Since Duvalier
