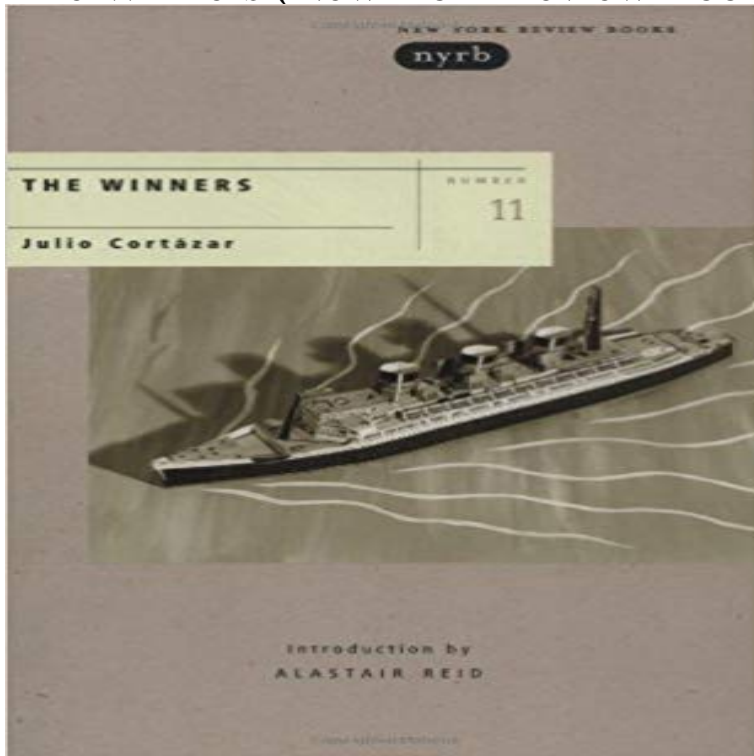


## The Winners (New York Review Books)
